

NT "ONE ANOTHER" commands

Be at peace with one another - **Mark 9:50**

you also ought to wash *one another's* feet - **John 13:14**

A new commandment I give to you, that you love *one another*: just as I have loved you, you also are to love *one another* - **John 13:34**

By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for *one another* - **John 13:35**

This is my commandment, that you love *one another* as I have loved you - **John 15:12**

that you may bear fruit...These things I command you, so that you will love *one another* - **John 15:17**

so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members *one of another* - **Romans 12:5**

Love *one another* with brotherly affection. Outdo *one another* in showing honor...serve the Lord...contribute to needs of saints...show hospitality - **Rom 12:10-15**

Live in harmony with *one another*. Do not be haughty, but associate with the lowly. Never be conceited, wise in your own sight...live peaceably - **Romans 12:16-21**

Owe no one anything, except to love *each other*, for the one who loves *another* has fulfilled the law... you shall love your neighbor as yourself - **Romans 13:8**

Therefore let us not pass judgment on *one another* any longer, but rather decide never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother - **Rom 14:13**

May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with *one another*, in accord with Christ Jesus - **Romans 15:5**

Therefore welcome (accept) *one another* as Christ has welcomed you, for the glory of God - **Rom 15:7**

you, my brothers, that you yourselves are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge and able to instruct *one another* - **Romans 15:14**

Greet *one another* with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ greet you - **Romans 16:16**

that you may learn by us not to go beyond what is written, that none of you may be puffed up in favor of *one against another*. What do you have that you did not receive? ..then why do you boast - **1 Cor 4:6-7**

When *one of you* has a grievance against *another*, does he dare go to law before the unrighteous instead of the saints? - **1 Corinthians 6:1 cf 1 Cor 5:12-13**

To have lawsuits at all with *one another* is already a defeat for you. Why not rather suffer wrong? Why not rather be defrauded? - **1 Corinthians 6:7**

Do not deprive *one another*, except perhaps by *agreement* for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come *together* again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of *self-control* - **1 Cor 7:5 (cf Eph 5:30 (22-33))**

So then, my brothers, when you come together to eat, wait for *one another* - **1 Corinthians 11:33**

on those parts of the body we think less honorable we bestow greater honor... that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for *one another* - **1 Corinthians 12:14-27**

All the brothers send you greetings. Greet *one another* with a holy kiss - **1 Corinthians 16:20**

when they measure themselves by *one another* and compare themselves with *one another*, they are without understanding - **2 Corinthians 10:12**

Finally, brothers, rejoice. Aim for restoration, comfort *one another* - **2 Corinthians 13:11**

agree with *one another*, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you - **2 Corinthians 13:11**

Greet *one another* with a holy kiss - **2 Cor 13:12**

For you were called to freedom, brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve *one another* - **Galatians 5:13**

But if you bite and devour one another, watch out that you are not consumed by *one another* - **Gal 5:15**

Let us not become conceited, provoking *one another*, envying *one another* - **Galatians 5:26**

Brothers, if *anyone* is caught in any transgression, *you* who are spiritual should restore him in a spirit of gentleness. Keep watch on yourself... Bear *one another's* burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ - **Galatians 6:2**

with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with *one another* in love - **Ephesians 4:2**

Therefore, having put away falsehood, let each one of you speak the truth with his neighbor, for we are members *one of another* - **Ephesians 4:25**

Be kind to *one another*, tenderhearted - **Eph 4:32**

forgiving *one another*, as God in Christ forgave you. Therefore be imitators of God - **Ephesians 4:32**

addressing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody to the Lord with your heart - **Ephesians 5:19**

understand what the will of the Lord is... submitting to *one another* out of reverence for Christ - **Eph 5:21**

Do not lie to *one another*, seeing that you have put off the old self with its practices - **Colossians 3:9**

Christ is all, and in all. Put on compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, patience, bearing with *one another* if one has a complaint against another, forgiving *each other*, as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive - **Colossians 3:12-13**

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing *one another* in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God - **Colossians 3:16**

and may the Lord make you increase and abound in love for *one another* and for all, as we do for you - **1 Thessalonians 3:12**

Now concerning brotherly love you have no need for anyone to write to you, for you yourselves have been taught by God to love *one another* - **1 Thess 4:9**

we will always be with the Lord. Therefore encourage *one another* with these words - **1 Thess 4:18**

Therefore encourage *one another*, and build *one another* up - **1 Thessalonians 5:11**

Be patient with them all. See that *no one* repays anyone evil for evil - **1 Thessalonians 5:15**

but always seek to do good to *one another* and to everyone - **1 Thessalonians 5:15**

We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for *one another* is increasing - **2 Thessalonians 1:3**

For we ourselves were once foolish, disobedient, led astray, slaves to various passions and pleasures, passing our days in malice and envy, hated by others and hating *one another* - **Titus 3:3**

But exhort *one another* every day, as long as it is called "today," that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin - **Hebrews 3:13**

And let us consider how to stir up *one another* to love and good works - **Hebrews 10:24**

but encouraging *one another*, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near - **Hebrews 10:25**

Do not speak evil against *one another* - **James 4:11**

Do not grumble against *one another*, brothers, so that you may not be judged - **James 5:9** cf 1 Cor 5:12-13

Therefore, confess your sins to *one another* and pray for one another, that you may be healed - **James 5:16**

by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love *one another* earnestly from a pure heart, since you have been born again - **1 Peter 1:22**

Above all, keep loving *one another* earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins - **1 Peter 4:8**

Show hospitality to *one another* without grumbling - **1 Peter 4:9**

As each has received a gift, use it to serve *one another*, as good stewards - **1 Peter 4:10**

Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward *one another* - **1 Peter 5:5**

Greet *one another* with the kiss of love. Peace to all of you who are in Christ - **1 Peter 5:14**

But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with *one another* - **1 John 1:7**

the message that you have heard from the beginning, that we should love *one another* - **1 John 3:11**

And this is His commandment, that we believe in the name of his Son Jesus Christ and love *one another*, just as He has commanded us - **1 John 3:23**

Beloved, let us love *one another*, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God - **1 John 4:7**

Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love *one another*. If we love *one another*, God abides in us and His love is perfected in us - **1 John 4:11-12**

not as though I were writing you a new commandment, but the one we have had from the beginning—that we love *one another* - **2 John 1:5**

love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, all your strength...and, you shall love your neighbor *as yourself*... there is no greater commandment - **Mt 22:39; Mk 12:31; Lk 10:27**

more **"TOGETHER"** in the Lord (NT)

And all who believed were *together* and had all things in common... And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts - **Acts 2:44,46... gathered together Acts 5:12; 12:12; 14:27; 15:6; 15:30; Acts 20:7**

that *together* you may with *one* voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ - **Romans 15:6**

I appeal to you, brothers, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to strive *together* with me in your prayers to God - **Romans 15:30**

the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints *together* with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours - **1 Cor 1:2**

when you come *together* as a church, I hear that there are divisions among you... when you come *together* to eat, wait for one another...so that when you come *together* it will not be for judgment - **1 Cor 11:17-34**

If one member suffers, all suffer *together*; if one member is honored, all rejoice *together* - **1 Cor 12:26**

When you come *together*, each one has a hymn, a lesson, a revelation, a tongue, or an interpretation.

The churches of Asia send you greetings. Aquila and Prisca, *together* with the church - **1 Cor 16:19**

Working *together* with him, then, we appeal to you not to receive the grace of God in vain - **2 Cor 6:1**

for I said before that you are in our hearts, to die *together* and to live *together* - **2 Corinthians 7:3**

made us alive *together* with Christ - **Ephesians 2:5**

in Whom the whole structure, being joined *together*, grows into a holy temple in the Lord. In Him you also are being built *together* into a dwelling place for God by the Spirit. - **Ephesians 2:21-22**

eager to maintain the *unity* of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body and one Spirit - **Eph 4:3-4**

until we all attain to the *unity* of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ - **Ephesians 4:13**

from whom the whole body, joined and held *together* by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love - **Ephesians 4:16**

I ask you also, true companion, help these women, who have labored *side by side* with me in the gospel together with Clement & the rest of my fellow workers, whose names are in the book of life - **Philippians 4:3**

And He is before all things, and in Him all things hold *together* - **Colossians 1:17**

that their hearts may be encouraged, being knit *together* in love, to reach all the riches of full assurance of understanding and the knowledge of God's mystery, which is Christ - **Colossians 2:2**

holding fast to the Head, from whom the whole body, nourished and knit *together* through its joints and ligaments, grows with a growth that is from God - **Colossians 2:13,19**

And above all these put on love, which binds everything *together* in perfect harmony - **Colossians 3:14**

will be caught up *together* with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and so we will always be with the Lord. - **1 Thessalonians 4:17; 2 Thess 2:1**

more "UNITED" in the Lord (NT)

united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be *united* with him in a resurrection like his. - **Rom 6:5**

I appeal to you, brothers, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you *agree*, and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be *united* in the *same* mind and the *same* judgment. - **1 Cor 1:10**

for we are God's *fellow workers*. You are God's *field*, God's *building*. - **1 Corinthians 3:9**

Do you not know that you are God's *temple* and that God's Spirit dwells in you? If anyone destroys God's *temple*, God will destroy him. For God's *temple* is holy, and you are that *temple*. - **1 Cor 3:16-17**

Do you not know that your bodies are *members* of Christ? ...But he who is *joined* to the Lord becomes one spirit with Him.... Or do you not know that your body is a *temple* of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? - **1 Corinthians 6:15-20**

For in one Spirit we were all baptized into *one body*... Now you are the *body* of Christ and individually *members* of it - **1 Corinthians 12:12-27**

Let all things be done for *building up* - **1 Cor 14:26**

What *agreement* has the temple of God with idols?

For we are the *temple* of the living God; as God said, I will make My dwelling among them and walk among them; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. - **2 Corinthians 6:16**

So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith... the promises were made to Abraham and to his offspring...who is Christ... For as many of you as were *baptized into Christ have put on Christ*. There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither slave nor free, there is no male and female, for you are *all one* in Christ Jesus. And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise. - **Galatians 3:9,16,28**

So then, as we have opportunity, let us do good to *everyone*, and especially to those who are of the *household* of faith - **Galatians 6:10**

for we are members of His body - **Ephesians 5:30**

so that I may hear of you that you are standing firm in *one* spirit, with *one* mind striving *side by side* for the faith of the gospel - **Philippians 1:27**

having the *same* mind, having the *same* love, being in full *accord* and of *one* mind. Do nothing from rivalry or conceit, but in *humility* count others more significant than yourselves. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Have *this mind* among yourselves, which is *yours in Christ* Jesus - **Philippians 2:2-5**

let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in *one body* - **Colossians 3:15**

you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a *spiritual house*, to be a *holy priesthood*, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God. - **1 Peter 2:5**

all of you, have *unity* of mind, sympathy, brotherly love, a tender heart, and a humble mind. - **1 Peter 3:8**

To those who have obtained a faith of *equal standing* with ours by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ: May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord - **2 Peter 1:1-2**

Do your best to speed Zenas the lawyer and Apollos on their way; see that they lack nothing. And let our people learn to *devote themselves* to good works, so as to help cases of urgent need, and not be unfruitful. - **Titus 3:13-14** (cf 1 John 3:5-8)

because I hear of your love and of the faith that you have toward the Lord Jesus and *all the saints*, and I pray the sharing of your faith may become effective for the full knowledge of every good thing that is in us for the sake of Christ. For I have derived much joy and comfort from your love, my brother, because the hearts of the *saints* have been refreshed through you. - **Philemon 1:5-7**

these who cause divisions, worldly people, devoid of the Spirit. But you, beloved, *build yourselves up* in your most holy faith; pray in the Holy Spirit; *keep yourselves* in the love of God - **Jude 1:19-21**

1. The Lord...proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord, a God merciful and gracious...abounding in steadfast love" (Exodus 34:6).
 2. You shall love your neighbor as yourself (Leviticus 19:18).
 3. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might (Deuteronomy 6:5).
 4. It was not because you were more in number than any other people that the Lord set his love on you and chose you...but it is because the Lord loves you and is keeping the oath that He swore to your fathers (Deuteronomy 7:7-8).
 5. Yet the Lord set His heart in love on your fathers and chose their offspring after them (Deut. 10:15).
 6. But I have trusted in Your steadfast love (Psalm 13:5).
 7. His steadfast love endures forever (Ps. 106:1).
 8. In His love and in His pity He redeemed them (Isaiah 63:9).
 9. I have loved you with an everlasting love; therefore I have continued My faithfulness to you (Jer. 31:3).
 10. the Lord said to me *Hosea*, "Go again, love a woman *Gomer* who is loved by another man and is an adulteress, even as the Lord loves the children of Israel, tho they turn to other gods" (Hosea 3:1).
 11. I will love them [Israel] freely (Hosea 14:4).
 12. Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you (Matthew 5:44).
 13. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart & with all your soul & with all your mind & with all your strength. The second is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these. (Mark 12:30-31)
 14. For God so loved the world, that He gave his only Son (John 3:16).
 15. The Father loves the Son (John 3:35).
 16. If you love Me, you will keep My commandments (John 14:15).
 17. I [the Son] love the Father (John 14:31).
 18. If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in His love (John 15:10).
 19. As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you. Abide in My love (John 15:9).
 20. Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?... Nothing in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord (Romans. 8:35, 39).
 21. Let love be genuine (Romans 12:9).
 22. Owe no one anything, except to love each other (Romans 13:8).
 23. Love is the fulfilling of the law (Romans 13:10).
 24. Knowledge puffs up, but love builds up (1 Corinthians 8:1).
 25. And I will show you a still more excellent way [love] (1 Corinthians 12:31).
 26. If I...understand all mysteries and all knowledge...but have not love, I am nothing (1 Corinthians 13:2).
 27. The greatest of these is love (1 Corinthians 13:13).
 28. Pursue love (1 Corinthians 14:1).
 29. Let all that you do be done in love (1 Corinthians 16:14).
 30. For the love of Christ controls us (2 Corinthians 5:14).
 31. The fruit of the Spirit is love (Galatians 5:22).
 32. But God...because of the great love with which He loved us...made us alive together with Christ (Ephesians. 2:4).
 33. To know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge (Ephesians 3:19).
 34. Walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us (Ephesians 5:2).
 35. And this is my prayer, that your love may abound more and more with knowledge and all discernment (Philippians 1:9).
 36. And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony (Colossians 3:14).
 37. May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all (1 Thessalonians. 3:12).
 38. The aim of our charge is love (1 Tim. 1:5).
 39. And let us consider how to stir up one another to love (Hebrews 10:24).
 40. Love one another earnestly from a pure heart (1 Peter 1:22).
 41. Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins (1 Peter 4:8).
 42. Whoever does not love abides in death (1 John 3:14).
 43. By this we know love, that He laid down his life for us (1 John 3:16).
 44. Let us not love in word or talk but in deed and in truth (1 John 3:18).
 45. Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God (1 John 4:7).
 46. God is Love (1 John 4:8).
 47. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins (1 John 4:10).
 48. We love because He first loved us (1John 4:19)
 49. Keep yourselves in the love of God (Jude 21)
 50. To him [Jesus] who loves us and has freed us from our sins by His blood (Revelation 1:5)
